


## Honeymoon in the Serengeti with Micato

In addition to the more than two million wildebeests and hundreds of thousands of zebras and gazelles that are perpetually on the move as part of the Great Migration — the largest such migration in the world — on a safari in Serengeti National Park you're going to see buffalo and hippos, as well as elephants, lions, giraffes, baboons and warthogs. More elusive, but very much a possibility, are the park's cheetahs, jaguars, and the endangered black rhino. The animal kingdom is alive and well here; there are baby animals galore.
